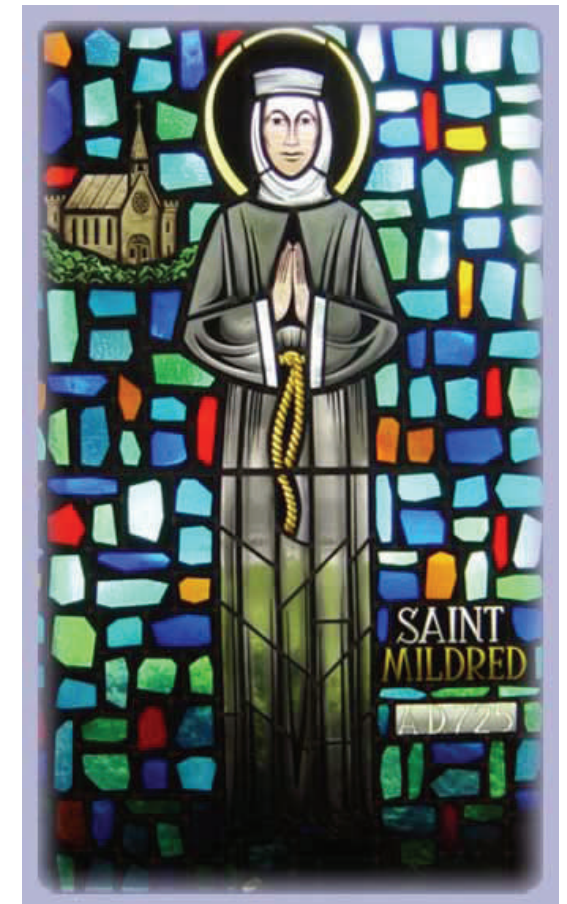

How We Serve
