How quickly can a quilt be obtained?

† We will do our best to create and deliver a quilt within 2 weeks.
Our volunteers will try to complete them as quickly as possible.

How can I help?

- † We meet once a week as a group.
- † We need fabric sorters and cutters during the work sessions.
- † You can sew at your convenience and bring the quilt once completed.
- † You can look for donations of supplies or visit garage sales for 'treasures'.
- † We need record keepers and correspondents to handle requests.
- † If you've never sewn, or think you can't sew, COME ANYWAY!
We are willing to share our knowledge to grow this ministry.

What do the quilts look like?

† The quilts are typically lap-size and may be a variety of styles or patterns.

Are the quilts free?

- † YES. A donation for supplies or shipping is always welcome.
- † If you want to donate, send a check to St. Mildred Catholic Church, Swansboro, NC. In the memo line, write: **PRAYER QUILT**

What supplies are needed?

- † Cotton batting and cotton fabric
- † Rotary cutters and rubber mats
- † Thread for tying the quilt (#5 Pearl Cotton)
- † Sewing machines
- † Irons and ironing boards
